Communication and Language

The children will be encouraged to listen to stories about pirates, space, superheroes, magic and minibeasts.

To develop their sentence structure we will continue to model full sentences and key words from the topic.

We will be continuing Talk homework set on Google Classroom.

We will re-start language bags and send home Snuggle bear for children to document their adventures.



Physical Development

We will be experimenting with different ways of moving, such as skipping, hopping and jumping. To develop our fine motor skills we will start to participate in Dough disco sessions.

We will be starting our just dance sessions in Nursery in the mornings.

We will be practising to hold a pencil correctly and form some or all letters from our names. Children starting Reception in September will be encouraged to write their names.

Literacy

This term we will be listening to and retelling stories and we will encourage the children to join in with repeated refrains. To develop their writing skills the children will be mark making with different tools including chalk, paint, foam and crayons.

We will be starting phonics in Nursery this term. We will be following the Read write Inc programme.

Expressive Arts and Design

Understanding the World
