Personal Social and Emotional Development

- We will be learning to play with others and take turns
- We will learn to work as a team
- We will learn to tell others when they are doing something we don't like
- We will be willing to try new activities

Communication and Language

- We are developing our vocabulary by learning new words and using them in our play.
- We will read non-fiction texts and know that we can find information from them.
- During our story sessions, we will retell and act out the story using props

Physical Development

- Learning large ball skills such as catching, throwing, kicking, patting
- Please encourage the children to change all by themselves. They need to be able to put their hat and gloves on as well as zip up their coat.
- We will continue to work on our letter formation, making sure we form them correctly.

Literacy

- Our first topic will be fairy tales with a twist. The children will learn about famous stories with a slight twist on the original story
- During the second half term we will learn all about growing and read stories about growing,
- We will continue to practice our handwriting
- We will be continuing our phonics journey. We will read and write simple words using our sounds.

Make independent choices.

Active learning

 Begin to correct their mistakes themselves. For example, instead of using increasing force to push a puzzle piece into the slot, they try another piece to see if it will fit.

Creating and thinking critically

- Know more, so feel confident about coming up with their own ideas.
- Make more links between those ideas
